10 Principles agreed during Cost to Go workshops undertaken during w/c 02/08/2021

- All Station Tier 1's to be substantially demobilised from sites by the end of 2021**
- Station Tier 1 Demobilisation date to be no more than 90 days from SC3ROGS date
- Tier 1 Contract Closeout will be no more than 90 days from Demobilisation date
- Dependency on MoBo will be removed within 90 days of commencement
- 5) From 1st January 2022, the local delivery model will be disbanded to be reformed into 3 core closeout delivery teams

- 6) All post Revenue Service EOWLs to be removed from Tier 1 contractor scope and to be delivered by an ADM or deferred under the auspices of the COO and TfL
- 7) ATC (C610) to be substantially demobilised from sites by the end of 2021
- 8) From 1st January 2022, ATC will not act as default Principal Contractor for the COS
- 9) From Dec 2022, Siemens (C620 and C660) will substantially demobilise from Crossrail
- 10) Substantial ramp down of CRL Programme staff by December 2021.
